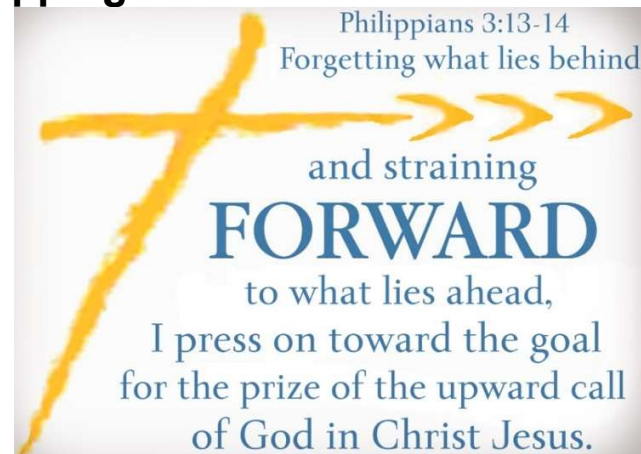
Prayer Items:
